

SOP FOR POPULATING THE WATCHER LIST

1. Patients populating the Watcher's List need to be identified during morning and evening handover safety briefing at 8.30 and 20.30.
2. Once Watcher list has been agreed in safety briefing, it is the duty of the general paediatric ward on-call lower specialty trainee to call PICU on behalf of the general paediatric team. Either of the paediatric specialties on-call lower specialties trainees should do the same on behalf of the specialties team.
3. It should always be the duty of the receiving team to call the Watchers number after receiving handover.
4. The SBAR tool should be used when transferring information.
5. In case on-call team members are not present at the handover, the duty of calling the Watchers number has to be delegated to any other members of the team who have attended the handover.
6. Should Watchers be identified during the shift, it is the duty of each individual team to notify PICU.
6. PICU should receive minimum two calls in 24 hours to populate the Watchers list. This means there needs to be calls to PICU after morning and evening handover regardless if there are patients to report about or not.
7. If there are any doubts by any team member whether a patient should be put on the Watcher list, please be advised by the senior decision maker in your team.

IMPORTANT: The aim of the Watcher List is to raise situational awareness and DOES NOT constitute a review request.
